


A focus on novel experiences is the next frontier in luxury travel

About 200 miles north of the Arctic Circle lie three huge lakes frozen in impermeable ice. Travellers are chauffeured down to the frozen tracks where they can drive these marvellous machines. The vehicles are engineered specifically to help find the right grip and balance. When ice and rubber create friction, this supercar can easily manoeuvre itself out of the snow and ice.

PORTUGAL ON YOUR OWN STEAM (BIKING IN PORTUGAL)

The Portugal which the world knows consists of the sun shining down on the Algarve coast as tourists make their way to the beach. Portugal on a bike is a life-changing experience. We believe that exploring Portugal through the confines of a car does not do justice to the beauty of this destination.
